Construction to Begin on Mount Tabor Road Bridge in Menallen Township

Adams County Bridge to be replaced as part of Public-Private Partnership

Harrisburg, PA – Mount Tabor Road bridge, spanning Opossum Creek in Menallen Township, Adams County, is scheduled to close on June 12 as part of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation’s (PennDOT) Rapid Bridge Replacement Project. Replacement of this bridge will allow PennDOT to remove it from Adams County’s structurally deficient bridge list. Mount Tabor Road is officially designated as State Route 4005. When the bridge closes on June 12, drivers will be directed to follow a detour along Route 34 (Carlisle Road), Gablers Road (Route 4003), and Route 4008. The new bridge should open to traffic in late August. In the event of unfavorable weather or unforeseen activities, this schedule may change.

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In the event of unfavorable weather or unforeseen activities, these schedules may change. These bridges are referred to as JV-233 and are one out of the 558 bridges being replaced under the Rapid Bridge Replacement Project. JV references the joint-venture partnership between Walsh/Granite, which is leading construction for the entire project. The Rapid Bridge Replacement Project is a public-private partnership (P3) between PennDOT and Plenary Walsh Keystone Partners (PWKP), under which PWKP will finance, design, replace, and maintain the bridges for 25 years. The P3 approach will allow PennDOT to replace the bridges more quickly while achieving significant savings and minimizing impact on motorists.
